



# Chippewas of Nawash First Nation (ALFDC)

## On-Reserve LMI Pilot Project

Summary of survey data up to June 2020

### Community Survey

**153** completed surveys → **19%** of the On-Reserve 15+ population

As more of the population is surveyed - the more precise the information becomes

Based on the current number of respondents in this community, the accuracy of the data is within + or - 7 percentage points.

### Education

**60%** completed at least some Post-secondary



**79%** also reported other licenses or certificates

**12%** reported other training or courses

### Job status

When taking into account **traditional and occasional jobs**



**Traditional skills jobs** include things like fishing, hunting, crafts, guiding

**Occasional/informal paid jobs** include things like babysitting, repairs, cleaning

### Most common skills



Outdoor maintenance



Cooking, preparation and/or preservation of food



Hunting, fishing and/or trapping



### Least common skills



Computer programming, creating apps



Repairing appliance, small engines, motors



Navigating and guiding

### Most common jobs

Early childhood educators and assistants

Retail and wholesale trade managers

Social and community service workers

Biological technologists and technicians

Cashiers

Landscaping and grounds maintenance labourers

Elementary and secondary school teacher assistants

Home support workers, housekeepers and related occupations



### Future intentions



**34%** plan to go back to school in the next year



**48%** are interested in future training



**49%** are interested in receiving job notifications matching their skills and interests

A better picture of the experience, training and skills of community members and the challenges faced will help to connect people to available jobs and help those that want to get new skills and qualifications.
