In this role, you will:

- Support students’ individual learning needs, including those outlined in IEPs, while fostering confidence, engagement, and belonging
- Assist teachers with classroom instruction, activities, and daily operations
- Promote student safety, positive behaviour, and well-being using restorative practices
- Supervise students during recess, lunch, and extracurricular activities
- Contribute to a culturally inclusive environment by integrating Anishinaabe knowledge and perspectives
- Support classroom organization, preparation of instructional materials, and use of technology
- Participate in team meetings, professional development, and collaborative school initiatives
- Maintain confidentiality and adhere to all school and MCFN policies and procedures
